

Population and Geographical Area Served by the Community Storehouse

Our service area includes portions of Tarrant, Denton and Wise Counties, approximately 306 square miles of territory, where over 5,978 economically disadvantaged school-aged children in the Keller and Northwest Independent School Districts qualify for our assistance. With a total student population of 38,128 for both school districts, our challenges continue to increase with growth and impacting economic conditions. This target population identifies the children that are below the poverty level outlined by government standards. Since these have been identified as two of the fastest growing school districts in the state, the need for our services is growing as well.
